

Inuit Living Outside of Nunavik

In Québec in 2016, the number of Inuit living outside of Nunavik was equal to the population of Kuujjuaq: there are today in Québec 2 140 Inuit living outside of Nunavik. This proportion (15%) increased by 2.5% between 2006 and 2016. It is lower than the proportion of Canadian Inuit living outside of Inuit Nunangat, i.e. 27%.

About these Comparisons

These comparisons regarding the demographic situation of Nunavik between 2006 and 2016 have been made possible by the recent publication of data from the 2016 Census of Canada.



HOW HAS THE POPULATION CHANGED IN TEN YEARS?

Between 2006 and 2016, the population of Nunavik has grown by 2 300 inhabitants. If the population of Québec had grown at the same pace, it would today total 9 million. This is one highlight of the past ten years. To mark its tenth anniversary, the Nunivaat Program has compiled noteworthy demographic statistics.

Community Sizes

Over ten years, the population in every community has grown. In the largest communities, this growth has been more significant. Today, close to two thirds of the population of Nunavik reside in four of the 14 communities.

Presence of Women

The proportion of women in the population of Nunavik has increased, especially in the largest communities. While women today represent 49.3% of the population of Nunavik, this proportion is still lower than for all of Québec (-1.5%).


Age

The population of Nunavik remains much younger than the population of Québec as a whole. The median age in Nunavik is 23.5 years old. In Québec, it is 42.5 years old. Distribution by age group shows an upward trend in the age of the population: the median age has increased from 21.8 years old in 2006; the proportion of very young individuals is diminishing; and the proportion of older individuals is increasing.


USE OF INUKTITUT (%)



Language

Inuktitut has conserved and even expanded its place in Nunavik. The Inuit language is still spoken in 86% of households in the region. Inuktitut is today spoken at work by close to two thirds of the population, representing an increase of 6% in ten years.

Education

Over ten years, educational statistics have changed. The number of individuals with no diploma has diminished, while the number of those with secondary diplomas has increased. Even while there are more than 2 200 postsecondary graduates today, the proportion of postsecondary graduates in the population decreased from 2006 to 2016 by -3%. In relation to men, women hold proportionally more secondary diplomas, but fewer postsecondary diplomas.
